

## Thank you for reading our 2022 Impact Report.

This report is our way of celebrating and sharing with you what you have helped make possible in the last year. It is also an opportunity to provide details about our operations, finances, programs, and partners.

Each year, as I produce this report, I find myself reflecting in awe while simultaneously looking forward with excitement as we begin the growing season. This time of year, is one of renewal and light: the sun's warmth, the greens and yellows of the flowers and sprouting vegetable gardens, and drawn-out evenings for sitting outside. For Wayside, it means a renewed abundance of locally grown foods coming through our warehouse to share with our partners or to prepare for our Pop-up Picnics and Community Meals.

My good fortune in experiencing this cycle reminds me that it is a blessing and a privilege to live where I can enjoy that sun and share fresh vegetables and flowers from my yard. This year, I am also thinking of the people of Ukraine who, only a few years ago, also enjoyed the same change of season and the incredible bounty of sunflowers that their country produces for the entire world.

The sunflower (Helianthus annus) has been a staple of Ukrainian exports for decades, flourishing in its dry, arid climate. Valued by pollinators with big, golden, and unapologetically cheerful heads always reaching for the sun, they have become a symbol of peace and resiliency. Since the war began, people from other nations have used sunflowers to symbolize solidarity with the Ukrainian people.

Maine farms and gardens will soon be supplying Wayside with their bounty of fresh, seasonal produce. Much like the Ukrainians' relationship with sunflowers, our farms and farmers have an inextricable connection with the people of Maine and are symbols of Mainers' resiliency rooted in our interdependence. Because the growing season is short, we value every donation of fresh produce and welcome the opportunity to share it with our community. We have so much to be thankful for this year. We hope you do too.

Since 2014, the Boston-based non-profit Sunflower of Peace has been raising funds to support the people of Ukraine. At the beginning of the war, Sunflowers of Peace focused their mission on supporting the needs of medics working on the front lines. Recently they have focused additional resources on ensuring access to high-quality trauma-informed psychological care for Ukraine's POWs. www.sunflowerofpeace.org




